



RESOLUTION NO. 18-2018

**MOTU PROPRIO RECOGNITION OF HUMAN RIGHTS VIOLATIONS
VICTIMS PURSUANT TO R.A. 10368**

Motu Proprio Resolution declaring certain Filipinos who fought, struggled, suffered and resisted the Marcos dictatorship as Heroes of the Filipino People pursuant to Republic Act No. 10368 of “The Human Rights Victims Reparation and Recognition Act of 2013.”

Whereas, Section 26 of R.A. No. 10368 partially provides that “persons who are HRVVs, regardless of whether they opt to seek reparation or not, shall be given recognition by enshrining their names in a Roll of Human Rights Victims to be prepared by the Board.”

Whereas, Section 20 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. No. 10368 provides in Section 20 thereof thus:

“Section 20. Motu Proprio recognition. The Board may take judicial notice Motu Proprio of individual persons who suffered human rights violations as defined herein and grant such persons recognition as HRVVs and enshrined in the Roll of Human Rights Violation Victims.”
